DENMARK REPORT





COPENHAGEN LOCATION REPORT



We are writing this second quarter update knowing that Evelina and I were on parental leave for most of it. We are blown away by the amazing people we get to build church with! What we have seen the last three months is a testament to your hard work, prayers, selfless sacrifice, love and above all, God's faithfulness ! Thank you Hillsong Copenhagen (every individual and family who call our church home) for the part that you play in what God is doing in and through our church. It is such an encouragement to see how we are moving forward in all areas of church life, and even more importantly, hear the stories of lives being impacted!

Baptism

In the last three months we have seen 19 people get baptized. There is nothing like celebrating with people as they decide to bury their old lives with Christ and be raised up to a new life with Him. That is what it is all about ! Each one of these individuals have powerful stories of how Jesus has met with them and how this has resulted in a dedication to follow Him.

Baby Dedication

Jesus said: Let the little children come to me (Matt 19:14). We are following in this tradition when we stand with the parents who are dedicating their babies, praying for God's blessing over them. 8 children have been dedicated these last few months. Big congratulations to all the parents !

Youth Dedication

On the 28th of April we celebrated with 4 teenagers who were youth dedicated. This involved joining a course that takes you through the foundational aspects of our faith and was concluded with a moment in our Sunday service where they both shared and was prayed for.

Connect Groups

As we keep growing as a church there is also a continual need for us to get smaller. Our connect groups are spaces where we can share life and faith with others. We really believe in the power of community and it is exciting to see more people step up to lead groups as well as join them. In the last few moths we have started 4 new connect groups and we currently have 19 groups in total.

Basecamp

We recognize that we have seen a lot of people join our church lately. This is both people giving their lives to Jesus for the first time, as well as people coming "back to church" or those who relocate to Copenhagen. We therefore put on a four week course in April called Basecamp. The goal was to give people an introduction to "who we are", "what we believe" and "how we operate" as a church.

Faith Mission Partners and Entrepeneur Night Through Faith Mission Partners, we are committed to fostering a community that will build your faith and courage for our collective mission, grow healthy life-giving relationships, and be inspired to achieve great things for God! Our Entrepeneur Nights are a part of this initiative. In April we put on a night focusing on Al. We had Peter Vester, who is an industry expert and a long time member of our church, share and answer questions. There was also time for community and connection, which is always a focus on these nights.

Young Adults

We have seen a big focus on building community these last few months among our young adults. They have met for bi-weekly Bible studies, "girls who" and "guys who" social events and summer hang outs. This community also continues to be an important part of our Sunday evening services.

Youth

Spring has been a great season for our youth ministry! Our Youth Night on the 19th of April was phenomenal with powerful worship, preaching, people giving their lives to Jesus and a whole lot of fun. There has been hangouts in the park with picnic and games, movie nights and Friday gatherings with worship and prayer. Another highlight was the youth summer party celebrating the end of the academic year!

Youth continues to be an important part of our Sunday evening services with weekly hangouts at 16:00 before the service starts. During the service they can always be spotted sitting together up the front.





COPENHAGEN KIDS REPORT

We have had 3 good months in Hillsong Kids, on the team we have continually grown in our relationship and team spirit, we have added a few Kids Leaders to the team, and are hoping that this next quarter will lead more volunteers to our ministry.

We started April and May with focusing on the Holy Spirit in our Chapter 4, in Kids we dived deep in the fruits of the spirit, in our youngest age group they learned a fun song about the different fruits and in our older age group our amazing communication department made an activity book for the kids to take home after we had gone through all the fruits of the spirit, this was a fun way to end the chapter and we pray that the activity book will serve as a reminder to the kids about the amazing helper we have in the Holy Spirit.

Community

Every Sunday the kids gets to win points for their tribes and at the end of the season the winning tribe wins a playdate at Jumpyard. These past 3 months we took out 2 of the tribes for a fun time, the kids created deeper bonds, and the parents had a chance to sit down and talk, what a win/win.


Touching Heaven Night

Introducing our new Creative Pastor



We are pleased to provide a comprehensive review of our financial performance for the second quarter of 2024. This period has presented both challenges and opportunities for our church, as reflected in our financial results. We are committed to maintaining transparency and providing detailed insights into our financial health as we continue to navigate through a dynamic environment.


Financial Overview Income

Our total income for the quarter stood at 2,826k DKK, which was 1,139k DKK above budget; mainly due to one-off donation budgeted in Q1 2024. Our total income was 337k DKK above previous year (PY). Year To Date (YTD), our total income stood at 4,116k DKK, which was 259k DKK below budget and 106k DKK below PY.

Increase in income in Q2 reflects a positive trend.

- T&O income was slightly above expectations, showing some positive developments.
- **Foundation** (Faith Mission Partners & Heart for the House) contributions slightly exceeded our budget, due to timing.
- Other Donations were significantly above budget due to a timing shift, with these funds were budgeted to be received in Q1.
- Other Income also contributed positively against the budget, and slightly higher than PY.

Income:

Despite the slow start to the year, we are seeing a positive trend in collections during the year. The graph above illustrates the growth in total collections. However, it must be acknowledged that we are still tracking behind targeted budget goals.

Expenses

Total expenses amounted to 2,312k DKK, which is higher than the budgeted by 122k DKK but slightly lower than PY by 29k DKK. Efficient management of operational expenditures helped mitigate some financial pressures.

- Venue expenses were lower than budgeted, and came in lower than PY, reflecting our ongoing efforts to control costs.
- **Personnel** costs were higher than budgeted, **impacted by** personnel costs no longer covered by foundation support, and we experienced further application declines.
- **OPEX**, despite challenges, we successfully mitigated some expense increases by reducing operational costs, resulting in a 32% savings compared to the budget and a 46% reduction in OPEX versus same period in 2023.

Profit for Church Activities

The profit outcome for this quarter was significantly above our expectations, posting a profit of 514k DKK against a budgeted loss of 504k DKK. This combined with the loss in Q1 represents a considerable deviation from our planned financial path, largely driven by lower income due to the deferred donations, partially offset by controlled spending.

GIVING OPPORTUNITY



As we continue our journey together in faith and fellowship, we are presented with opportunities to support our church financially through two distinct methods. We want to share these options with you, along with their unique benefits, so that each of you can prayerfully consider how you would like to contribute.

Method One: Tithing

Regular Tithing - Your consistent contributions help sustain our worship services, outreach programs, and community initiatives. Through your faithful giving, you become partners in advancing God's kingdom here on earth. You can transfer gifts to our Danish bank accounts (international bank details listed below). If you wish to give a fixed amount regularly, such as each month, an easy solution is to set up a recurring monthly transfer via your Internet banking.

Letter of Support - For those who tithe with a letter of support, additional benefits are available. In Denmark, tithing with a letter of support allows individuals to give up to 15% of their income to the Church and receive approximately 30% tax deductions on their contributions. This means that your giving not only supports the church but also provides you with a tangible financial benefit.

Tax Deduction of Your Gift - Hillsong Denmark is approved as a non-profit organization (Almen velgørende forening) under the Tax Assessment Act (Ligningsloven). Therefore, gifts can be deducted on your annual tax return. The right to deduct your gift is capped at 18,300 DKK (2024 level) annually. However, by signing a Letter of Support (Gavebrev), your gift is instead capped at 15% of your personal income, plus net income from capital.

GIVING OPPORTUNITY



Method Two: - Hillsong's Faith Mission Partners Program

Another way to contribute to the work of the church is through Hillsong's Faith Mission Partners Program. This program offers a unique opportunity to partner with Hillsong in our local mission endeavors. Becoming a Faith Mission Partner also provides you with exclusive benefits. One such benefit is access to entrepreneur guest speakers and networking opportunities. Through breakfasts, seminars, and other events, you'll have the chance to connect with like-minded individuals, learn from experienced entrepreneurs, and grow both personally and professionally.

In conclusion, we invite you to prayerfully consider these two methods of financial contribution and how you can play a part in advancing God's kingdom. Whether through tithing and Hillsong's Faith Mission Partners Program, your generosity makes a difference in the lives of others and brings glory to God.
