




### **THANKS**

A Church where every person is valued, every story matters, and every heart finds a place to call home.






### THE ALPHA COURSE

We believe every woman is part of this beautiful community.




### **FAITH MISSION PARTNERS**




### COMMUNICATIONS

### **LETTER OF SUPPORT**

For those who tithe with a letter of support, additional benefits are available! In Denmark, tithing with a letter of support allows individuals to give up to 15% of their income to the Church and receive approximately 30% tax deductions on their contributions. This means that your giving supports the church and provides you with a tangible financial benefit.

### **TAX DEDUCTION OF YOUR GIFT**

Hillsong Denmark is approved as a Non-Profit Organization (Almen velgørende forening) under the Tax Assessment Act (Ligningsloven). Therefore, gifts can be deducted from your annual tax return. The right to deduct your gift is capped at 18,300 DKK (2024 level) annually. However, by signing a Letter of Support (Gavebrev), your gift is instead capped at 15% of your personal income plus net income from capital.
