GLOBAL SENIOR PASTORS

First and foremost, we'd like to extend the biggest THANK YOU to each of our church communities, and to every volunteer and staff member for your vital part in building His church, your steadfast commitment to serving His people, and your faithful love for Him.

Welcome to the second Mission Impact update of the year! This is so much more than a report. It's a faith-stirring testimony of God's goodness across Hillsong Church globally. We hope these pages will inspire and inform you in equal measure. Since our last update in June, we've witnessed a fresh awakening of God's presence through gatherings like Hillsong Conference in Sydney and London, the Sisterhood One Days, Men's Nights and Conferences, and, of course, our weekly church services held across 124 locations worldwide.

Following our Hillsong Conference in Sydney, we gathered for our Lead Pastors Day – a meaningful time to deepen our conversation around our evolving identity as a church. Together, we reflected on our new values and the heart behind the behaviours that will help shape who we are becoming as a community. It was a privilege to introduce new Regional Support roles and our Head of Ordination. These are key appointments that will provide additional support to our lead pastors and their churches. You'll find more details on these roles in this update. Since then, we have had another Lead Pastors Gathering following Hillsong Conference in London, where we spent meaningful time together and provided valuable input on our global strategy.

A highlight of building church is gathering each Sunday and seeing all the incredible people in our congregations worshipping Jesus, growing in their faith, and connecting with each other. It was pure joy to visit many of our global locations in the latter half of this year. We spent a truly memorable time with our church family in Europe, including our teams and pastors in Milan and Amsterdam. During a visit to Cape Town in July, we had the honour of announcing Scott (Sanga) and Kety Samways as the new Lead Pastors of Hillsong Africa, first to our staff team and then to our church. These were incredibly special and Spirit-filled moments (and quite emotional for us) as we prayed for them and passed on the leadership mantle for the church we planted back in 2008.

Returning to Australia, we were blown away by the faith-filled atmosphere of our first-ever Sisterhood One Day. We were equally encouraged by the praise reports that started pouring in from our global locations about how the Sisterhood One Days had blessed and refreshed the women of our church.

In September and October, I (Phil) travelled to Los Angeles, Toronto, and New York. It was really wonderful to be with our church in Canada as they celebrated their fifteenth anniversary and incredibly fruitful to join our New York staff in valuable team health workshops.

The blessing of belonging to a global church family means we can rally to support each other and pray for each other. Some of our lead pastors and their church communities are facing extreme trials and challenges in parts of the world that are in the grips of armed conflict, war-torn, or have been hit by disaster. We are especially mindful of Damon and Emily in Israel, Yuri and Natasha in Ukraine, Vadik and Anya in Moscow, and Juan and Damsy in Spain. They are faithful leaders who are courageously serving their communities and bringing the hope of Jesus amidst great challenges. Let's keep lifting them up in prayer and finding practical ways to help them however we can.

It's been a pivotal few years for our church as we've navigated a journey of transition and change. This season has required us to recalibrate, focusing on healthy governance, vision, and mission. Galatians 6:9 (NIV) has become a guiding verse for us: *"Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up."*

Together, we've persevered and are beginning to see the fruits of this journey—growing church health, increasing attendance, and more lives being transformed by Jesus. This year, we've also made meaningful progress in supporting our global church through the establishment of the Global Support Team and Global Support Framework. Looking ahead, we believe we're stepping into a new season of building the church with fresh joy, faith, and courage.

As you read through this Mission Impact update, we hope you feel a sense of what we've achieved together through His Spirit. Our vision is to keep building a healthy church that changes lives through Christ. We pray that every person who walks through our doors – now and in the future – will find a place they can call home, where they can build lifelong friendships and share the journey of faith in close community.

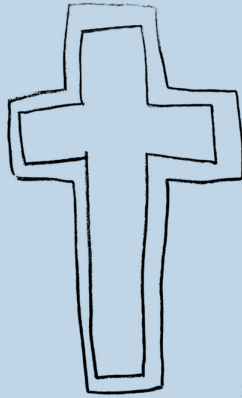
Finally, we want to extend our deepest appreciation to our Global Board and Spiritual Advisory Team for their ongoing support, encouragement, guidance, and prayer.

College

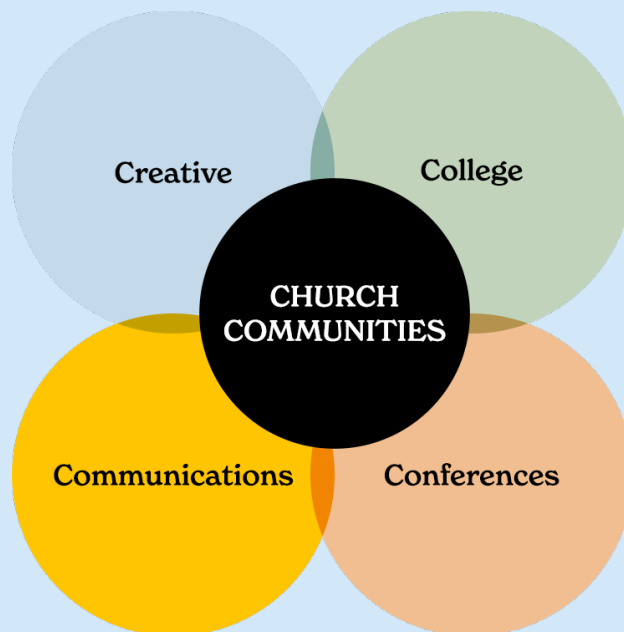

Our Communications team is dedicated to innovating ways to share the message of Jesus with the world. Through Christ-centred content, online engagement, and digital strategies, we aim to build the church, empower mission, and foster discipleship both online and in-person.

As part of our commitment to strengthening our global structure, we are excited to share some key updates regarding our Global Support Team. The role of this leadership team is to support all our global locations while overseeing and operating Hillsong Global in the areas outlined in the structure on the previous page.

In July 2023, we introduced Tolu Badders as our Global Chief Operating Officer, providing strategic leadership for our global operations, and Jonathon "JD" Douglass as Creative Pastor, serving both the Global and Australia regions while contributing to the creative vision of our church. AN UPDATE FROM TOLU BADDERS

GLOBAL CHIEF OPERATING OFFICER



In our last [Mission Update](#) we introduced the Global Support Framework, designed to help us achieve our mission, grow sustainably, equip our lead pastors, and cultivate a healthy leadership culture, while ensuring effective accountability. This framework is built around four key components: accountability, care, development, and resources. The goal is to empower our lead pastors to lead effectively, build healthy churches, and change lives through Christ.

This quarter, we've made significant progress in care and accountability. Key developments include the appointment of Regional Support Oversight leaders: Gary Clarke, Mário Boto, Richard van der Kolk, and Steve Dixon. Their leadership will play a vital role in providing guidance and support to our lead pastors across different regions.

In addition, we've made strides in the area of Credentialing, which is now called Ordination, to better reflect its spiritual and leadership significance. Duncan Corby has been appointed as the Head of Ordination. With 28 years of experience as a Senior Lecturer and key leadership team member at Hillsong College, Duncan brings invaluable expertise. He has also been a dedicated member of our church for over 40 years. Joining Duncan on the Ordination Team is Margaret Aghajanian, who will

focus on wellness. Margaret has faithfully served as Head of Pastoral Care in Australia for many years and brings a deep understanding of the care needs within our pastoral teams. Their full bios can be viewed on our [website here](#).

Together, Duncan and Margaret will work collaboratively with our global church to strengthen the ordination and wellness processes. Their work will focus on developing frameworks and initiatives that enhance the quality, development, and support of our pastoral teams. Supporting them on the Ordination Team are Lisa Moore, helping design a new approach to ordination; Charissa Maloungila, helping administer our system; and Cathy Clarke and Joyce Dixon, helping pastor our pastors around the world.

We are grateful for the dedication and expertise of all those stepping into these roles and look forward to seeing how these changes will help us grow and thrive as a healthy global church.

Finally, I am pleased to share that Hillsong Church has engaged Tod Bolsinger's consultancy, AE Sloan Leadership, to develop a Global Strategic Plan in collaboration with leaders across our global church. Updates will follow as the initiative progresses.

SIGNIFICANT & SUSTAINABLE SOCIAL IMPACT



Compassion’s mission is to release children from poverty in Jesus’ name. For the past 70 years, they have worked alongside over 8,500 local churches, offering holistic care to more than 2 million vulnerable children in over 25 countries around the world.

Hillsong has been blessed to partner with Compassion for over 20 years, supporting local churches and witnessing the transformative power of Jesus in children’s lives. Together, we’ve had the privilege of seeing over 130,000 children and their families begin to break free from poverty through the generosity of sponsors, many of whom were connected through Hillsong’s advocacy at worship gatherings and conferences.

As a church, we remain focused on Uganda, where we’re grateful to be part of positive change in the lives of children, their families, communities, and the nation as a whole. The following page highlights three key areas where Hillsong has actively engaged in Compassion’s work.

In terms of the global picture, across all their 29 countries:

- 38,862 active sponsorships are linked to Hillsong at present
- 129,249 participants have been impacted by Hillsong sponsorships across the history of Compassion’s partnership with Hillsong



In September, some of our lead pastors and key team members travelled to Uganda with Compassion to witness their work firsthand. They visited the front lines of Compassion’s ministry, experiencing the beauty and resilience of local churches amidst poverty. It was an incredible opportunity to broaden their perspective and see God’s love at work, transforming children, families, and entire communities. The experience was truly special and highlighted the impactful work Compassion is doing alongside local churches and communities.

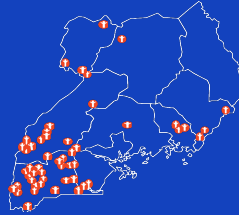

HILLSONG HAVE ENGAGED IN 3 ASPECTS OF COMPASSION'S WORK

1. Holistic Child Development Established in 2002



Compassion are the world's leading authority in holistic child development through sponsorship. Delivered through the local church, their core program model looks like this:

- It addresses the physical, spiritual, social, and cognitive development needs of a child. Child sponsorship supports this.
- There are 12,205 active sponsorships through Hillsong in Uganda.
- Hillsong supports over 30% of child participants at 51 frontline church partners delivering holistic child development (see map).

2. Hillsong UK / Europe Water Interventions: 'Since The Water Came' Impact Established in 2009



Compassion partners with thousands of local churches to bring safe water and improved sanitation to the children in our care. Our Water and Sanitation Fund provides access to safe water through boreholes, wells and rainwater catchment systems, safe and hygienic toilet facilities, and hygiene training to minimise health risks.

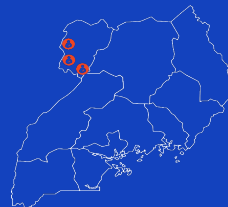

3. Child Survival



For babies born into poverty, the first 1,000 days of life are critical to survival. Our Child Survival interventions keep mums safe during their pregnancy by providing pre-natal and post-natal care, including check-ups, vaccinations and the presence of a medical professional during childbirth.

What's more, they help babies reach their first birthday by ensuring these precious children receive vaccinations, vitamins, nutritional supplements and growth checks.

Compassion Survival reaches thousands of babies and mothers around the world and helps ensure their critical needs are met immediately.

Hillsong UK have engaged in Child survival:

- Supported 3 centres (see map)
- Donated £51,368.20

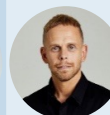
