
There are still so many people who need to discover the hope and love found in Jesus. Let's trust God to use us to reach the world He so deeply loves.


We look forward to gathering on Sunday, November 16, to share this moment of faith and unity together. Let's believe together for all that God will do in and through us this season.

## Our Heart for 2025

At Mission Sunday this year, we framed our year with the theme: "Take another step—in faith." This is a season in which God is calling us to move forward with greater faith, courage, and reliance on Him. As we approach our Heart for the Mission offering, we are grateful to God for the opportunity to support our mission and to respond boldly to all that He has called us to, through a special annual offering above and beyond our regular tithes and offerings.

This year, we are connecting our Heart for the Mission offering to our Mission Pillars, with the goal of strengthening our Francophonie campuses and equipping them to fully live out the three pillars of our mission:

#### Mission Pillars 1 & 2 - Purpose-Filled Jesus Followers and Healthy Church Communities:

These pillars support initiatives that advance Hillsong Francophonie's mission. This includes church planting goals, securing permanent locations for our seven campuses, obtaining permits, and beginning the fit out of new venues. It also includes ongoing support for our Local Campus initiatives. These efforts aim to build a discipleship culture that helps people discover their God-given purpose as they follow Jesus, whether through age-group ministries, discipleship programs, pastoral care, or weekend services.

Mission Pillar 3 - Significant and Sustainable Social Impact:

This pillar enables us to support CityCare and the Hillsong Africa Foundation, providing practical assistance to those who need it most.

We truly believe that as each of us takes a step of faith—both individually and collectively as a church—we will see God move in extraordinary ways. What God has planned for our church requires our shared faith, generosity, and faithfulness. We thank you for prayerfully considering how you can participate in this year's Heart for the Mission offering. Every step, every gift, and every act of faith makes a difference.

## **Local Campus**

#### Strengthening Our Campuses

We are grateful to see our campuses continue to grow. This year, weekly services have been established in Luxembourg, Lausanne has moved into a new venue, and Marseille continues to expand. For all our campuses, we want to provide operational and financial support to foster solid and sustainable growth. Our focus remains on strengthening each campus — operationally, in equipment, and in community life.

Paris, Geneva, Lyon, and Massy: need refreshed equipment, community and operational support. In Paris, new midweek facilities and potential offices are being explored for 2026 to strengthen both operations and community spaces.

**Lausanne**: Now in a new venue, additional equipment, instruments, and signage are needed to create a functional and welcoming home for the church.

**Luxembourg:** Having taken a major step forward with weekly services, we are partnering with them to strengthen operations and community as they continue to grow through 2025-2026.

Marseille: The campus has moved into a spacious and welcoming venue with expanded areas for children and opportunities to enhance community life.

We are also preparing for the future acquisition of a permanent building across all our campuses and, as always, are setting aside finances toward this long-term vision.





## Mission Pillars 1 & 2

#### **Purpose-filled Jesus Followers**

This Mission Pillar is all about helping individuals not only know Jesus but understand and walk confidently in their God-given purpose. Whether they are new to faith, or have been on the journey for decades, people across our church are being encouraged to take another step in faith. The goal isn't just information but transformation. The impact is a growing community of Jesus-followers who are anchored in spiritual disciplines, living out their faith with clarity, conviction, and courage in every sphere of life.

#### **Healthy Church Communities**

This Mission Pillar focuses on building local expressions of church that are strong, authentic, and life-giving. Healthy church isn't just about the Sunday service - it's about the relationships, support systems, spiritual vibrancy, and sense of belonging that form throughout the week. From large city hubs to small emerging locations, the vision is to foster connected communities where people are known, cared for, and empowered to live out their faith.

## Significant and Sustainable Social Impact

At the heart of this pillar is the conviction that, compelled by God's love, the church exists not just for those inside the building, but for the good of the world around us. Social impact means addressing real needs — locally, nationally, and globally — through intentional partnerships and practical acts of love, both for today and for future generations.

#### CityCare

CityCare is an expression of Hillsong Church, engaging with our local communities with the desire to see them flourish. It exists to build hope within vulnerable communities through programs run in partnership with local organisations and services.





#### 2024 Report & Impact

Eln 2024, we continued to witness the incredible generosity of our church community, and we are deeply grateful for your ongoing support. This year will be remembered as a season of spiritual, digital, and relational growth across all our campuses. Your giving enabled us to invest in various local initiatives, each carefully chosen to meet the unique needs of its campus and community. We look forward to advancing these projects as part of this year's Heart for the Missionoffering.

Paris: The campus continued to be a central hub of outreach, with lives transformed weekly and a vibrant, growing community.

Massy: The campus saw steady growth, with faithful weekl y attendance, significant baptisms, and increasing engagement in training programs such as Nouveau Départ and Parcours Découverte.

Lyon: With 51 services at Espace Ouest Lyonnais, stability and accessibility supported growth, particularly in the Kids ministry. Highlights such as Pentecost were marked by God's manifest presence, with several baptisms in the Holy Spirit, Sers Ta Ville strengthened local impact.

Marseille: An exceptional year with growth across all areas: decisions for Christ, baptisms, team engagement, the launch of new Connect Groups, and the Youth program. Increased financial faithfulness enabled the strengthening of multiple ministries and prepared the Food Truck for 2025. Social initiatives opened promising dialogue with the Métropole.

Geneva: Solid growth and spiritual maturity, with over 140 volunteers engaged. Children's, Creative, and Hispanic ministries expanded, and events such as church weekends and young adult services marked the year.

Luxembourg: 25 services at Kinepolis welcomed people from over 15 nations. Several Luxembourgish families found their place, and the first Luxembourgish-language Connect Group was launched. Sers Ta Ville Luxembourg supported two local organizations and distributed over 700 items.

Lausanne: Launch of Connect Groups with two monthly services since September 2024. Small-group meetings foster simplicity, worship, and fellowship, making this campus a dynamic spiritual hub, particularly for larger families.
