#### "Journey to the cross walk with me."

Luke 9:51 (MSG)
"When it came close to the time for his Ascension, he gathered up his courage and steeled himself for the journey to Jerusalem."

From chapter 9 verse 51 onwards, Luke records all the events in Jesus' life in the form of a journey to Jerusalem – leading him to the cross.

For Jesus, the purpose of this journey is our salvation through his death and resurrection. This Easter, we're following Jesus – His teaching and His example - as we seek Him and His kingdom.

This reading plan is designed to help you embark on your personal journey with Jesus and spend the four weeks leading up to Easter seeking Him with more passion, following Him more closely, and discovering His love more deeply.

We pray that this plan will bless you and help you grow in your relationship with Jesus.



As you prayerfully read the scriptures, imagine yourself sitting next to Jesus. Engage all your senses in every scene.

What does the location look like? What details do you see? Immerse yourself into the story and imagine what you smell, hear, taste and touch. Let these scenes unfold around you. Closely observe Jesus. Open your heart to His words, like a conversation with a dear friend. Take time during the day to reflect on everything you experienced.
