
PRAYER

Today, let us try to remember all the promises God has made to us. See if you can remember ten, write them down and try to memorise them.



Are there times when you find doing something you've been asked to do hard?


Ask Jesus to help you,

DEVOTIONAL





PRAYER


Lord Jesus, thank you for coming to the world and spreading your love. Help me to be able to share this love to someone around me today. Amen.

QUESTIONS


