WHY FORMA?

The word "Forma" originates from the Latin word "fōrma," meaning to shape and structure.

TWO TRACKS ONE SCHOOL

There are two tracks to choose from in 2026

01 BIBLICAL STUDIES02 LEADERSHIP

Both tracks have been designed to ensure students who may also be working full-time have the time to engage with school and studies.

All live online sessions are held on Wednesday evenings at 8pm (see page 7 for 2026 dates), and additional sessions are available on demand to learn at your own pace.

For both tracks, there are two national in-person days held in London: Induction and Chapel, and for those applying to leadership, two additional dates are included and provided in advance so you can plan ahead.

We have provided you with an average weekly commitment for both tracks so you can choose which track works best for you, and to what level you wish to study.

This is the average weekly time we estimate you will spend as a student at school, taking into account in-person days, online sessions, and recommended personal study time.

Written assignment

During the summer, all students will be given an extended writing assignment to complete based on one of the topics they have studied, and feedback will be provided.

BIBLICAL STUDIES

Foundational theology January–October 2026



2-4 hours average weekly commitment



60% solo study15% in person25% live online



This track is ideal for those who desire to deepen their understanding of scripture and build lifelong personal study patterns. Covering topics such as:

- Genesis & Exodus Creation and Covenant
- Proverbs and Ecclesiastes Wisdom for Everyday Life
- The Intertestamental Period The Time in between
- Jesus and The Synoptic Gospels The Life of Jesus Through the Gospels & Acts
- The Prison and Pastoral Epistles Paul's Letters to the Early Church
- Revelation The Letters to the Seven Churches

Students will be expected to attend the scheduled live online sessions and then receive on-demand sessions each week to learn at their own pace.

This track also includes one additional in-person local session, which will take place at your Hillsong Location during September and will be arranged during your studies.

LEADERSHIP

Practical ministry experience and personal leadership January–October 2026

As well as learning alongside the Biblical Studies students, so that you can grow in your foundational theology, those on the leadership track will also participate in additional live online sessions covering a range of leadership topics such as:

- Servant leadership
- Emotional intelligence
- Integrity and character
- Communication and influence
- Resilience and well-being

In addition to the two in-person days for Induction and Chapel, there are two Thursdays called 'staff days' when you're invited to spend the day with our UK-wide team in London. This includes attending our staff meeting and an additional in-person session.

These Thursdays will be a meaningful opportunity to connect, grow, and experience the heart of church life behind the scenes. As this may require time off work, attendance is optional.

There will also be one in-person local session which will take place at your Hillsong Location during April and will be arranged during your studies.

Practical ministry experience

During the second half of the school year, as a student on the leadership track, you will be involved in a location project that will be tailored specifically to your next step of development and provide you with hands on experience.

You can pay all at once or select 'pay in three' during the application process.

All fees must be paid in full by January 31st 2026.

Your school fees do not include any additional reading materials you may choose to purchase or your travel costs for in-person days. By providing you with all dates at the start of your school experience, you will be able to plan your travel ahead of time.

Once you've completed FORMA, you'll receive an alumni code that can be used to re-enrol for another year, switch to a different track, or share with someone interested in joining.

The code provides a £60 discount on enrolment.

APPLY TODAY

Applications take roughly 10-15 minutes to complete.

For those applying to the Leadership Track, once your application is received, you will be sent a link to schedule a 15-minute online call with a member of the school team.



Q. WHAT COURSE IS RIGHT FOR ME?

The Biblical Studies Track is ideal for those who desire to grow and deepen their understanding of the scriptures. It also offers the most flexible school experience, with fewer in-person days and more on-demand sessions available to learn at your own pace.

The Leadership Track would suit any individual who currently holds leadership responsibility within their church or workplace or aspires to do so.

With hands-on ministry experience included in this track, those who complete the Leadership Track are better equipped to carry responsibility and lead with integrity, both in their personal walk and in serving others.

Q. CAN I DO A SECOND YEAR?

Yes, as this is our first year of FORMA, 2027 will be slightly different, and we would love you to return for a second year. You will experience different content and contributors, and if you wish, switch tracks.

We strongly encourage those who are discerning church leadership and church planting to consider doing a second year on the leadership track.

Q. WHO WILL BE DELIVERING SESSIONS?

Alongside our national Hillsong UK leaders, we will be bringing a selection of incredible teachers and thinkers to contribute. During our first year, most of our sessions will be 'in-house' from the UK and Hillsong College.

Q. WHAT HAPPENS AFTER I'VE COMPLETED FORMA?

We hope you have the best time while at FORMA and look forward to seeing all students put everything they have learned into practice, either through building lifelong personal study patterns or leading with integrity in your church or workplace.

If FORMA has helped you discern your decision to pursue full-time vocational ministry, we want to help you as much as we can.

Q. WHAT IF I CAN'T PAY MY FEES IN FULL BY JANUARY 31ST 2026?

We have been mindful of keeping the costs of FORMA at an affordable rate; therefore, unfortunately, we cannot offer financial aid or additional discounts.

If you would like to defer your application to 2027, we can offer you an alumni code in advance,

which will reduce the standard fee for 2027 by £60. From there you can opt to pay via three instalments for 2027 when applications open early 2026.
