## INTRODUCTION

**1 Chronicles 4:9-10 NIV,** "Jabez was more honorable than his brothers. His mother had named him Jabez, saying, "I gave birth to him in pain." Jabez cried out to the God of Israel, "Oh, that you would bless me and enlarge my territory! Let your hand be with me, and keep me from harm so that I will be free from pain." And God granted his request."

### The prayer of Jabez is a simple yet profound cry to God.

It reveals the heart of someone who trusted deeply in God's character and sought His blessings, presence, purpose, and protection. Over the next four weeks, we'll explore each element of this prayer to discover how it applies to our lives and inspires us to grow in faith through intentional, expectant prayer. Let's allow this journey through Scripture to allow God's Word to challenge and transform us.

# A GROUP STUDY: THE PRESENCE OF GOD

Key Verse 1 Chron 4:10b says, "Let your hand be with me..."

#### Discovery

The "hand of God" in Scripture symbolizes His presence, power, and guidance. Jabez recognized that true success and security come only when God's hand is actively leading and sustaining us. He didn't want to rely on his own strength; instead, he sought God's constant companionship.

<u>Starting Question</u>: How often do you consciously invite God's presence into your daily decisions and actions? <u>Exploring Questions</u>:

1. What does it mean to have the hand of God with you? (Isaiah 41:10)
