


DOMESTIC FAMILY VIOLENCE RESPONSE

DOMESTIC FAMILY VIOLENCE RESPONSE

Please consider the following which will assist church to best support you and those involved:

- 1. Date and time of situation
- 2. Full names of all involved
- 3. Campus location
- 4. Contact phone numbers or emails
- 5. Details of the situation
- 6. Are you aware of, or suspect domestic and family violence is being perpetrated by an adult household member who normally resides in the home?
- 7. Are any children or pregnant women there?
- 8. Are you aware of an incident of domestic violence (observed by you or reported to you) that did not result in injury to a child/young person or psychological harm to a child/young person?
- 9. Do you suspect domestic violence based on your observations of extreme power/control dynamics (e.g., extreme isolation) or threats of harm to adults in the household?

Please consider these questions/concerns related to the perpetrator:

- 1. Used a weapon (gun, knife, etc.) or has access to a weapon
- 2. Attempted to kill household member(s) including attempting to strangle or suffocate?
- 3. Seriously injured an adult or pet?
- 4. Caused physical injury to a child/young person?
- 5. Seriously threatened to harm child/young person/adult/self?
- 6.1s there persistent domestic violence?
- 7. Has there been a significant increase in the pattern/level of violence?
- 8. Made a threat to or harmed a pregnant woman or a woman who has recently given birth
- 9.1s increasing severity or frequency of violence
- 10. Is stalking, is extremely controlling or has sexually assaulted parent or other adult household member
- 11. Has attempted suicide
- 12. Is non-compliant with a court order
- 13. Has significant mental health concerns or severe problematic alcohol or other drug abuse
- 14. Is causing the victim or other household members to be very fearful for their safety

Please consider these questions/concerns related to the Child:

- 1. Was physically injured
- 2. Attempted to intervene
- 3. Was in parent's arms or in close enough proximity to be hurt
- 4. Was significantly emotionally/psychologically distressed
- 5.Is the subject of a previous unborn child report related to domestic and family violence?
