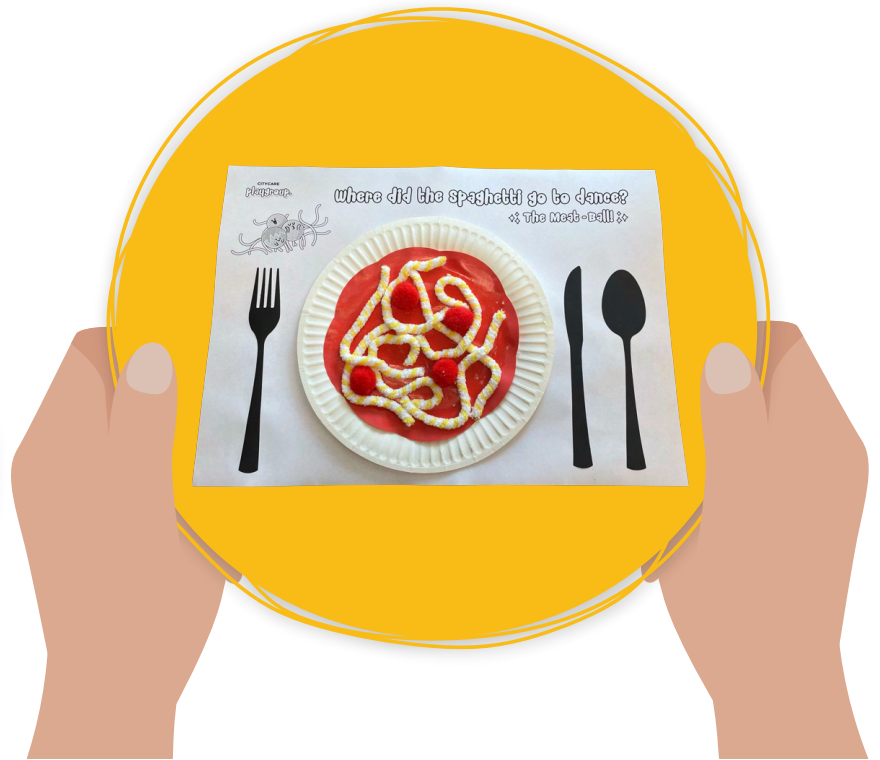


DANCING SPAGHETTI



PREPARATION

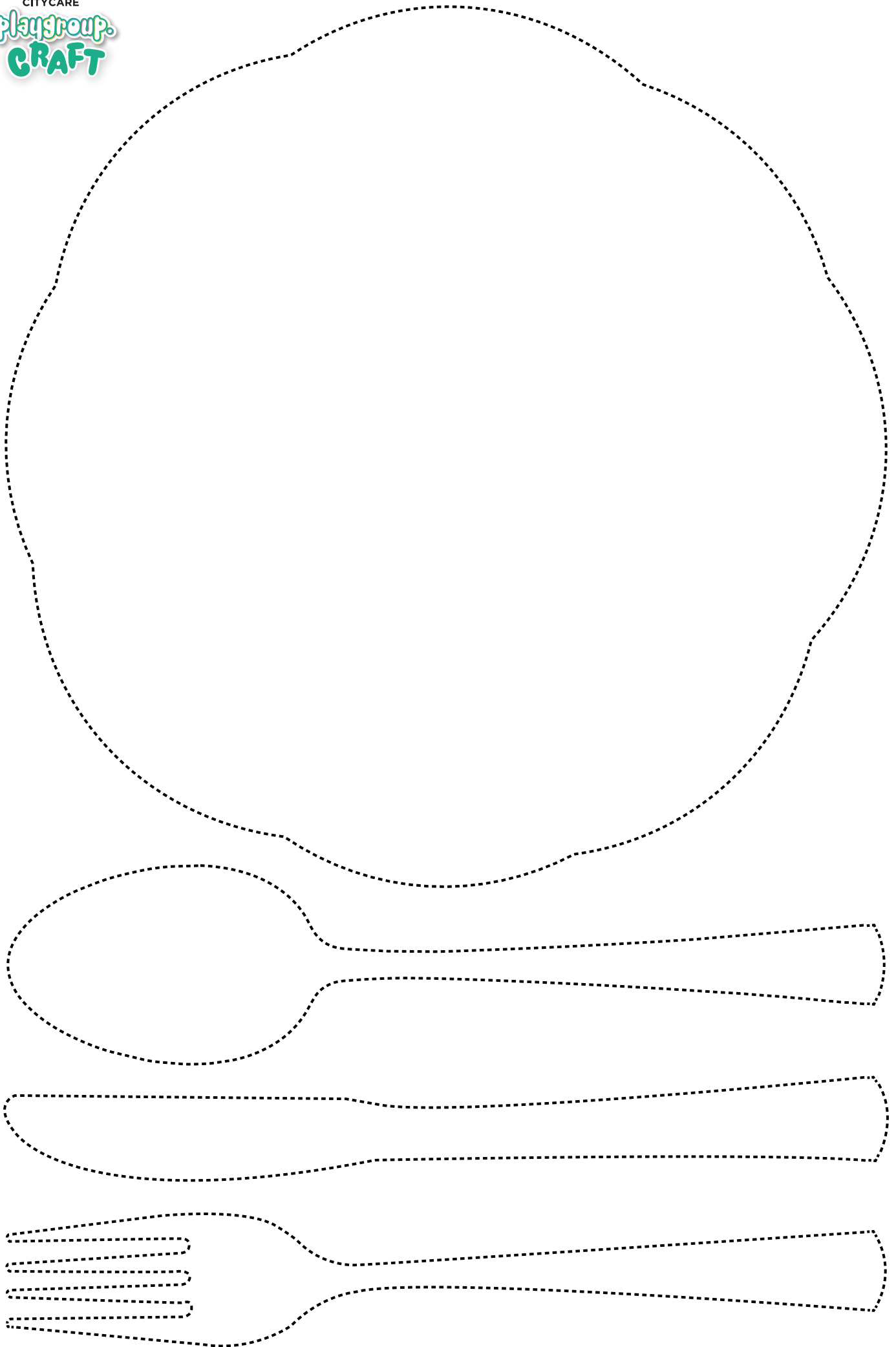
Before the craft session, please gather the necessary supplies, including printing sufficient stencil sheets for the number of crafts you'll be creating. Cut out all the shapes from the stencil to prepare for the activity, and be sure to create a sample craft as a visual reference on the craft table. This will help guide both children and parents as they engage in the craft activity.

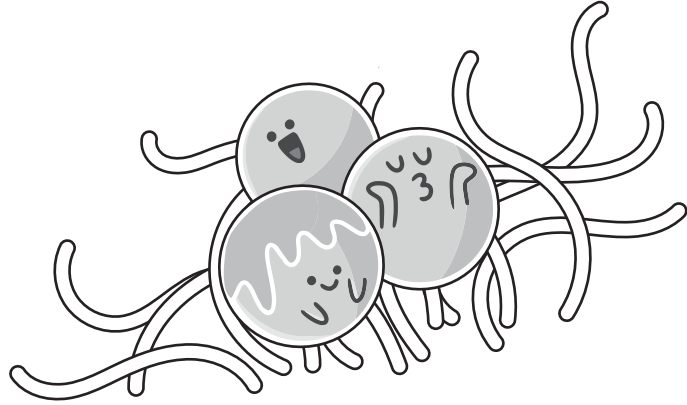
MATERIALS

- Glue
- PVA Glue
- Paint brush for PVA glue
- Paper plate
- Coloured pencils/crayons
- 10cm Yellow wool pieces
- Red pom poms
- Spaghetti A3 placemat print
- Knife, fork and spoon cutouts
- Sauce cutout

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Brush PVA Glue to the bottom of the paper plate and stick to the middle of the placemat.
2. Using a glue stick, glue knife, fork and spoon to the sides of the plate.
3. Brush PVA Glue to the plate and stick on the sauce cutout.
4. Brush PVA Glue on the sauce and apply wool for the spaghetti.
5. Add pom poms as the meatballs.
6. *Optional: Colour in the placemat.*
7. Write the child's name on it and let it dry.
