

GRASS HEAD



PREPARATION

Before the craft session, please gather the necessary supplies, including printing sufficient stencil sheets for the number of crafts you'll be creating. Cut out all the shapes from the stencil to prepare for the activity, and be sure to create a sample craft as a visual reference on the craft table. This will help guide both children and parents as they engage in the craft activity.

MATERIALS

- Water
- Soil
- Grass seeds
- Spoons
- Black marker
- Coloured pencils/crayons
- Paper cup with four holes in the bottom (for planting)
- Paper cup as is (for decorating)
- 'HELLO my name is' labels
- Face stickers

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Take a cup with no holes in it and decorate it with face stickers or draw on a face.
2. Write child's name on the 'HELLO my name is' sticker and place on the opposite side of the face.
3. Take the cup with holes in it and using a spoon fill $\frac{3}{4}$ of the cup with soil.
4. Place grass seeds in the top of the soil.
5. Sprinkle some more dirt to cover the seeds.
6. Pour in a little water to wet the soil and let dry.
