1 Peter 2:9 (NIV)

“But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God’s special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.”

THOUGHT

The world may try to tell us that we are ordinary, but God calls us extraordinary. At Sisterhood, we declare this truth together: you are not just a girl, you are so much more. Scripture reminds us that we are chosen, royal, holy, and His special possession. This identity changes everything. It means we don’t have to strive for worth – we already have it. It means our steps of faith carry weight, because we are set apart for His Kingdom purpose. And it means we can shine His light into the darkness, knowing who we are and whose we are.

REFLECT

God calls you chosen, royal, holy, and His special possession. Which of these truths do you most need to believe today, and how would it change the way you see yourself?

STEP

Write these words somewhere visible: *I am chosen. I am royal. I am holy. I am His.* Speak them over yourself every day this week. Note here what the Holy Spirit reveals to you as you embrace being His chosen.

PRAY

Lord, thank You that in Your eyes I am not ordinary. I am chosen, royal, holy, and Your treasured possession. Help me to believe this truth deeply, and to live as the woman You created me to be.
