WHAT IS SUMMER CAMP?

Summer Camp is an exciting opportunity for kids to grow in faith, build friendships and have fun! Through Jesus-focused rallies, discipleship groups, tribal challenges and outdoor adventures, kids will connect with Jesus and make unforgettable memories.

ALL STARS | GRADE 3-4 IN 2027

All Stars is a single day camp packed with fun activities and includes lunch and transportation.

VOLTAGE | GRADE 5-6 IN 2027

Voltage is a 2 night camp that allows kids to spend time with friends, engage in fun experiences and activities and develop a deep connection with Jesus.

CAMP FAQ'S

WHAT ADULT SUPERVISION IS THERE?

Kids are organised into groups of 6-20. Groups of 6 kids and at least 1 leader for those at Voltage Camp and groups of 20 kids and 3+ leaders for those at All Stars Camp. As well as that, we have extra leaders onsite looking after pastoral care, creative and operations. All of our leaders have completed our church Working With Children Check Process which includes a state based government check.

At each campsite the staff are highly skilled with experience in outdoor activities and managing campsites and campers. The campsite teams are specialised and trained to run all activities we do (including any water, beach, or heights based activities).

WILL MY CHILD HAVE FUN?

YES! Camps consists of a wide range of fun activities including tribal challenges, outdoor adventures (eg. archery, giant swings and abseiling) and small group activities. There is sure to be something for everyone.

HOW DO I HELP MY CHILD IF THEY ARE ANXIOUS ABOUT CAMP?

Talk positively about camp and ask your child what they're looking forward to. Share your own experiences of being away from home and reassure them that it's okay to feel nervous.

Try not to focus on how difficult being away might be or promise to pick them up if they don't enjoy camp. Instead, remind them of all the fun they'll have, the friends they'll make and that their Hillsong Kids Leaders will be there to support them.

Packing a familiar comfort item from home, like favourite PJs, a pillow, family photo or soft toy, can also help them feel more at ease.

WHAT HAPPENS IF MY CHILD GETS SICK OR INJURED AT CAMP OR HAS MEDICATION?

If your child becomes sick or is injured at camp, our Pastoral Care team is trained in First Aid and will care for your child. If this happens the team will contact you. Please make sure you use your current mobile phone number when registering.

Please give all medications your child needs to our Pastoral Care team at drop off and fill in the camp medication form.

CAN MY CHILD BRING A PHONE / HOW DO I CONTACT MY CHILD AT CAMP?

As part of our Child Protection Policy we ask that you do not send a phone with your child to camp. If your child needs to contact you during camp they can go to Pastoral Care. In the lead up to camp we will also provide all parents with the phone number of a pastor onsite who can be contacted during camp for any reason.

Any phones brought to camp will be kept in Pastoral Care for safety reasons.

Pre-Rego Price: Ends midnight 4th Oct

Early Bird Price: Ends midnight 6th Dec

Full Price: Until camp registration closes
